

Note from the nurse:

I am happy to be here to serve the health and safety needs of your children.

The first thing I will need from you is an up to date immunization record.

Fill out and sign the Certificate of Immunization (CIS).

OR If you are claiming an exemption, fill out the Certificate of Exemption (COE). A doctor must also sign this form. Please note that if there is an outbreak of a vaccine preventable illness, your child may be excluded from school for a time.

On each student, I will need a Health History. This information will help me plan for the health needs of your child. Please remember send the nurse an update when new health concerns arise or if there are changes in allergies or medications.

Throughout the year I will be monitoring for illness, assessing injuries, and taking care of medical needs.

If your child has a chronic disease that is potentially life threatening (such as asthma, severe allergies, diabetes, seizures, a cardiac condition, cystic fibrosis, or hemophilia) please fill out the Individual Health Plan (IHP) with your doctor before registering for school. Bring this information to the nurse **before** your child attends school.

If your child will need medication at school during the school day, please fill out a Medication Administration sheet (MAS) with your doctor and have an adult bring the medication to school. This includes all over the counter medications, such as Ibuprofen or Cough suppressant drops.

In the fall, all students will receive a vision and hearing exam. You will receive a letter if there are any concerns.

While we make every effort to have a safe school, accidents still happen. Please keep the office informed of any changes in phone numbers or emergency contacts. If your child severely injured, 911 may be called.
