Dear Lincoln Parents:

I would like to welcome all of you to the temporary home of Lincoln Elementary School! On behalf of the entire Lincoln staff, I extend a warm welcome and best wishes for a successful school year!

As many of you are aware, there are some big changes for the 2013-14 school year. Lincoln Elementary School will be located in the **Fruitland Building** at 201 South Garfield . This is due to our extensive one year remodel. On August 22, during our Open House you will be given a chance to look through the building, see your child's classroom and visit with staff and parents. I believe that, in partnership with you, this transition will be a smooth one.

School bus transportation is offered to all students who live in the Lincoln boundaries. Bus route information will be accessible by the week of August 15<sup>th</sup> on the district and school websites and also at Open House on August 22<sup>nd</sup>. It will also be published in the Tri-City Herald the weekend before school begins (Sunday, August 25th). If you have questions about busing, you may contact the KSD Transportation department at 222-5075. It is recommended that you walk the route to and from the bus stop with your child(ren) *before* the first day of school. Also, send your child(ren) to the bus stop no more than five minutes before designated pick-up time. **Bus pick-up/drop-off will be in the back parking lot behind the building (south side, by Lampson stadium). Buses only will be permitted in this area before and after school.**

For those parents who choose to transport their child(ren), **Parent parking and student pick-up/drop-off will be in the front parking lot of the building (north side, opposite Lampson stadium).** Please pickup and drop off your child along the sidewalk at the front of the building. If you choose to park in a designated parking space, please walk your child(ren) to/from your vehicle using the designated crosswalks. Keep in mind that it is unsafe for children walk through traffic within the parking lot. I highly encourage the use of the school buses for safety and traffic purposes. **Please use extreme caution!**

Class lists will be posted at the front entrance of the school beginning August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Supply lists and further information will be posted on the school website.

I look forward to seeing you and your children soon! This year will be an exciting adventure at the famous Fruitland/Lincoln building!
